## Decision about the fulfillment of requirements

Dear Professor Shynybekov,

We herewith inform you about the decision of the Accreditation Commission for Quality Management systems taken on 17 January 2018 regarding the fulfillment of the requirements for the award of the ASIIN System Seal to your institution mentioned below. Having taken into consideration the assessment of the expert panel, the Accreditation Commission took the following decision:

Institution	ASIIN-label	Accreditation until max.
International Information Technology University Kazakhstan	Requirement 4, 5 just partly fulfilled	Prolongation for one year.

The Accreditation Commission justifies its decision as follows:

The commission discusses the feedback of the experts to which the fulfillment of requirements can be attested.

Requirement **1, 2, 3** and **9** are fulfilled.

Requirement **4** and **5** are at this stage only partly fulfilled. The commission takes note, that the IITU has progressed, but further improvements need to be implemented. There is a possibility to demonstrate fulfillment of both requirements in the course of the upcoming program accreditation where the ASIIN experts will pay particular attention to the actions implemented by IITU. The commission will accordingly evaluate the reports of these program accreditations to come to a final conclusion whether the accreditation can be extended to a full six year period. In the meantime, the accreditation for the systemseal will be extended for one more year.

Considerable progress has been made with regard to requirement **6**. The Accreditation Committee nevertheless decides to include the following reference into the notifying letter to IITU:


“IITU is being indicated that the development of access to internationally acknowledged e-journals will be reviewed in the context of the re-accreditation.”

IITU has presented a convincing concept to fulfill requirement **7**. Its implementation also will be thoroughly reviewed in the context of the reaccreditation.

Concerning requirement **8** the commission notes considerable progress though more needs to be done. This again will be checked in one years time. seems to be in some parts a subjective feeling. In connection with the circumstance, that “Usability” is not a main question of accreditation, the commission sees, that is still much to do, but overall it is much improved.

With this letter we send you the updated accreditation certificate.
